Marge has 8 apples. She gives 3 apples to her friend. How many apples does she have left? $8 - 3 = 5$	5	
There are 2 red balloons and 9 blue balloons. How many balloons are there in total? $2 + 9 = 11$	11	
If you have 34 marbles and you give 6 to your friend, how many marbles do you have left? $34 - 6 = 28$	28	
Rick has 27 stickers, and he wants to share them equally among his 3 friends. How many stickers will each friend get? $27 \div 9 = 3$	9	
If there are 17 ducks in the pond, and 4 more ducks join them, 12 pencils in a box. how many ducks are there now? $17 + 4 = 21$	21	
$12 - 8 = 4$	4	

Gerry has 44 lollies, and he wants to put them into 4 jars with an equal number in each. How many lollies will be in each jar? $44 \div 4 = 11$	11
There are 7 days in a week. If you have completed 5 days, how many more days are left?	2
Rose has 38 toy cars. She gives 9 of them to her brother. How many toy cars does she have left? $38 - 9 = 29$	29

Section 4 : Subtraction Word Problems	Score : 10/10
Karl had 64 model dinosaurs. He gives 25 to his friend Alex. How many model dinosaurs does Karl have now? $64 - 25 = 39$	39
There are 46 students in the class. If 13 students are absent, how many students are present that day? $46 - 13 = 33$	33
There were 75 apples in the basket. After eating 19, how many apples are left in the basket? $75 - 19 = 56$	56
Mia had 45 stickers, and she gave 17 to her friend. How many stickers does Mia have left? $45 - 17 = 28$	28
If there are 74 pencils in the box, and you take 36 out, how many pencils are left in the box? $74 - 36 = 38$	38
Dan has 78 toy cars, and he wants to keep 32 of them. How many toy cars will he give away? $78 - 38 = 40$	40
There are 62 balloons at the party. If 35 balloons pop, how many balloons are still good? $62 - 35 = 27$	27
There are 68 cookies on the plate. After eating 39 of them, how many cookies are left? $68 - 39 = 29$	29
There were 71 students in the school bus. If 8 students got off at the first stop, how many students are still on the bus? $71 - 8 = 63$	63
Nick has 72 marbles, and he wants to sell 51 of them. How many marbles will he have left? $72 - 51 = 21$	21

Section 5 : Challenge	Answer
If I read 28 pages of my book and the book has 85 pages, how many pages do I have left to read?	$85 - 28 = 57$
Nathan has a big ant farm. He decided to sell some of his ants. He started with 965 ants. He sold 213. How many ants does he have now?	$965 - 213 = 752$ $900 - 200 = 700$ $60 - 10 = 50$ $5 - 3 = 2$
Ashley bought a big bag of candy to share with her friends. In total, there were 296 candies. She gave 105 candies to Marissa. She also gave 86 candies to Kayla. How many candies were left?	$296 - 105 - 86 = 105$
Cayley earns \$5 an hour by delivering newspapers. She delivers newspapers 3 days each week, for 4 hours at a time. After delivering newspapers for 8 weeks, how much money will Cayley earn?	$\$5 \times 4 = 20$ per day $20 \times 3 = 60$ per week $60 \times 8 = 480\$$
If you have 80 tickets for the fair and each ride costs 5 tickets, how many rides can you go on?	$80 \div 5 = 16$
